Instructions for Converting UTC Times to Local Time in Excel

These instructions will help you view your environmental readings with timestamps in your local time zone instead of UTC.

Using the Excel Macro

First-Time Setup:

- 1. Open your environmental readings file in Excel
- 2. Enable the Developer tab (if not already enabled):
 - Click on File > Options
 - Select Customize Ribbon
 - Check the box next to Developer on the right side
 - Click OK
- 3. Open the Visual Basic Editor:
 - Click on the Developer tab
 - Click on Visual Basic (or press Alt+F11)
- 4. Add a new module:
 - Right-click on "VBAProject" in the left panel
 - Select Insert > Module
- 5. Copy and paste the macro code:
 - Copy all the code from the "UTC to Local Time Excel Macro" file we provided
 - Paste it into the new module window
 - Close the Visual Basic Editor (you can click the X in the corner)

Using the Macro with Any File:

- 1. Open your environmental readings file in Excel
- 2. Run the macro:
 - Click on the Developer tab
 - Click on Macros
 - Select "ConvertUTCtoLocalTime" from the list
 - Click Run
- 3. Select your timestamp column:
 - When prompted, click on the column header that contains your UTC timestamps
 - Click OK
- 4. View your local time data:
 - A new column will be added to your spreadsheet with all timestamps converted to your local time zone
